Getting Ready for the Holidays

CROSS is beginning to plan for the Holidays. We distribute holiday food for Thanksgiving and Christmas. In addition we provide toys to over 1,000 children in our service area.

The Thanksgiving bag consists of a turkey, stuffing, potatoes, gravy, cranberry sauce, corn and pumpkin pie filling, green beans, corn, mandarin oranges and jello.

Our Christmas bag includes ham, scalloped potatoes, hot chocolate, baking

supplies, pears, pudding and corn.

The Marines along with local businesses and families contribute to the Toys for



Tots Campaign of which we provide toys to children in the community.

As the Holiday season progresses so does the need for food and toys for our families. Please consider do-

nating to one of these programs.

CROSS serves families in Maple Grove, Rogers, Osseo, West Champlin, Dayton and Corcoran. Bring your donations to CROSS during our regular business hours.

In 2011 we provided 1,716 Holiday Baskets which was 40,188 pounds and 1,083 toys.
